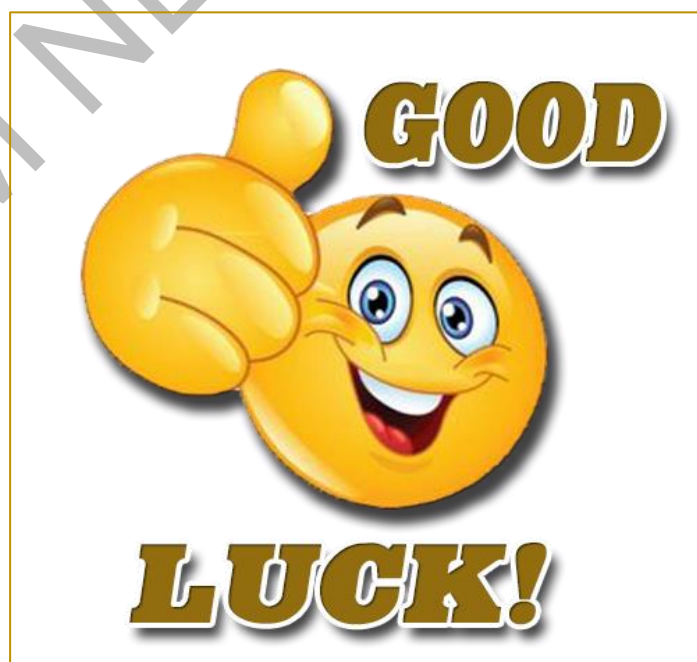
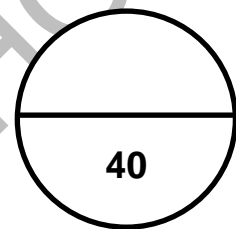

He said that witches came to the room in the night and turned him into a special boy with magical powers.
- 6 With each new lie, Pinocchio's nose grew longer and longer, until it was as long as the branch of a tree. "My nose, what happened to it?" he cried. Suddenly the fairy appeared in the room. "Perhaps you haven't been telling the truth," the fairy told Pinocchio.
- 7 From then on, Pinocchio began telling the truth and his nose became shorter and shorter, until it was back to normal. Pinocchio learnt his lesson and never told another lie again.
