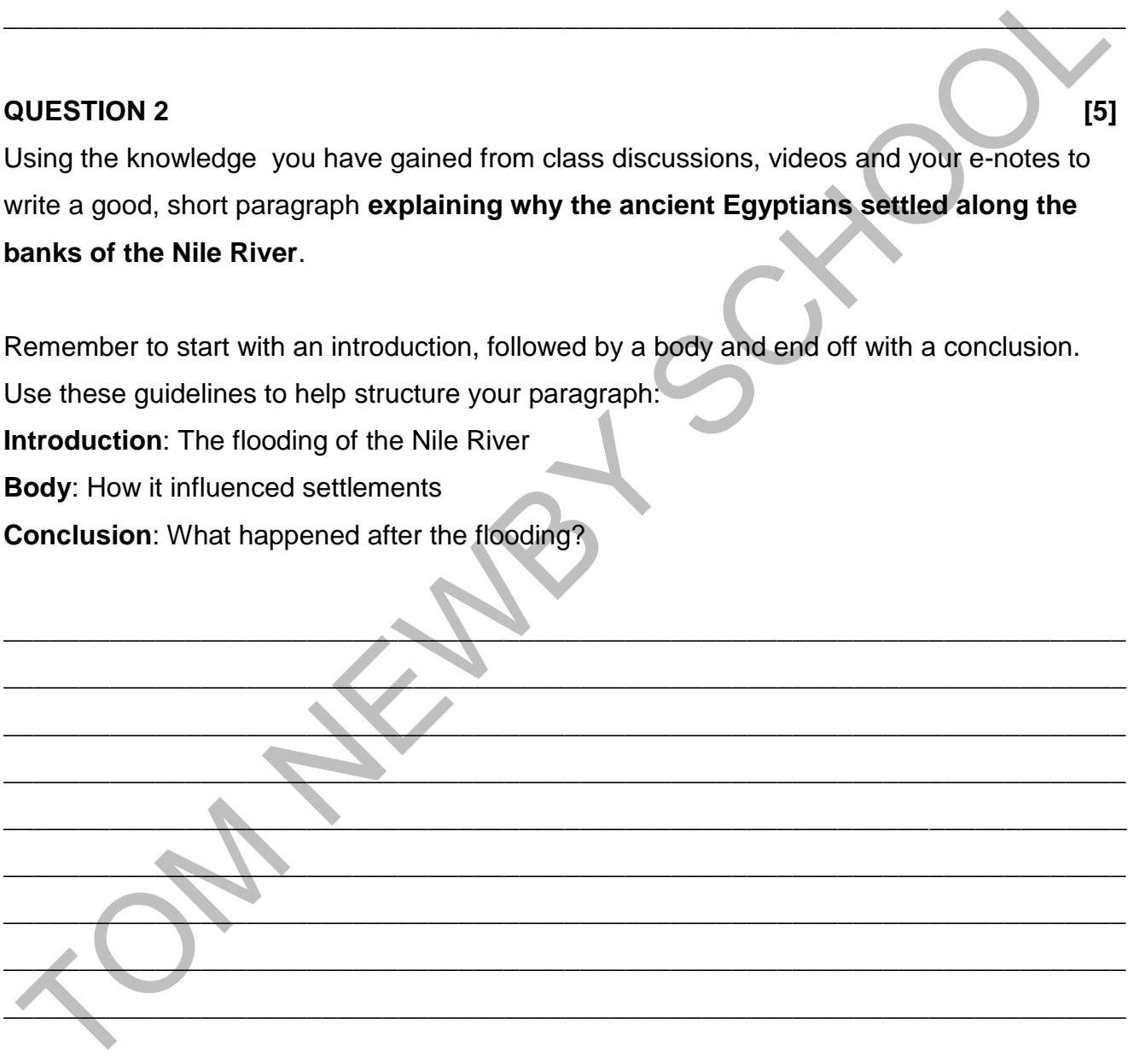
Remember to start with an introduction, followed by a body and end off with a conclusion.
