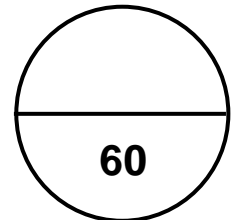

Trevor Noah – Giving back to Charity

1 Trevor Noah had one of the best weekends of his life when he played tennis with two champions, Rafael Nadal and Roger Federer, and one of the richest men in the world, Bill Gates, at Wimbledon 2020. It was all to support a good cause – raising money for the less fortunate in South Africa.

2 “To say tonight was a dream come true is an understatement because we helped raise R45 million rand towards education in Africa,” Trevor said with pride. “All this happened in my home country, South Africa. Thank you to every single person who supported this great cause. I have lived one thousand dreams in one night!”

3 Trevor Noah is the most successful comedian in Africa and is the host of the *The Daily Show* on Comedy Central. He also received three Emmy nominations: Outstanding Variety Talk Series, Outstanding Interactive Program and Outstanding Short Form Variety Series.

4 Trevor has starred in eight comedy specials. His latest comedy, “Trevor Noah, Son of Patricia” premiered on November 20 on Netflix. Trevor’s success also includes sold-out shows across five continents. In November 2016, Trevor released his first book, “Born a Crime: Stories from a South African Childhood” and it became an instant New York Times best seller, receiving the Thurber Prize for Outstanding Literary Work.

5 In April 2018, Trevor launched the Trevor Noah Foundation. This is a youth development initiative that prepares the youth for higher education or entry into the workplace. Trevor’s vision is a South Africa that advances because each generation builds and grows beyond its predecessor. Through a partnership with Microsoft, the foundation provides under-resourced schools with opportunities to use technology as a tool to enhance the learning experience as well as to increase digital literacy beyond the classroom.

6 Having come from humble beginnings, Trevor is now living a “what-dreams-are-made-of” life. He encourages all South Africans to reach for their dreams because no matter what the circumstances are, everyone can achieve their dreams, just like him!

Trevor Noah's Achievements

Trevor Noah is the most successful comedian in Africa, always keeping his fans entertained at every show. His 9th new comedy special, "Afraid of the Dark" will debut on Tuesday, February 21 on Netflix. The comedy was shot before a packed house in New York City at the Beacon Theatre.

Noah has hosted numerous television shows including South Africa's music, television and film awards, and two seasons of his own late-night talk show, "Tonight with Trevor Noah". He is the host of the Award winning "The Daily Show" on Comedy Central.

In November 2016, Trevor released his first book "Born a Crime: Stories from a South African Childhood". It was an instant New York Times bestseller, receiving the Thurber Award.

The Trevor Noah Foundation, is a youth development initiative, which aims to raise money to improve education in South Africa. The campaign has been launched on the Back-a-Buddy website to get as many children educated as possible.

Trevor Noah's net worth as of 2018 is estimated at R234 million. Noah acquired a new apartment in Manhattan New York City valued at R180 million. This house is identical to a 5-star hotel suite with 3 bedrooms and 5 baths.

Trevor Noah is currently a member of the New York Car Club. He once owned a Lamborghini and a Porsche, which he later sold after settling in New York and joining the car club. Now, he has access to whatever car he wishes to drive!
