John Ronald Reuel Tolkien achieved fame by writing a series of fantasy tales. He was born on 3 January 1892, in South Africa and he died on 2 September 1973 in England. Tolkien, his mother and younger brother, settled in England, after his father died in South Africa.

Tolkien was interested in invented languages and he created "Elvish" languages called Quenya and Sindarin. These became a primary part of the language that was spoken by the Elves in his writings. He was also interested in many other languages.

Tolkien achieved fame with his books, "The Hobbit" and "The Lord of the Rings", which were a series of fantasy tales. These books were set in a world of his own creation. They also grew from a desire to tell stories which were influenced by his love for myths and legends.

"The Hobbit" was a famous fantasy story, that revolved around a hobbit named Bilbo Baggins. Bilbo was a home-loving creature who is flung into an adventure to capture the treasure of the dragon named Smaug. Along the way, Bilbo comes across a ring, which becomes the central idea in "The Lord of the Rings" series.
