A. General Information

1. The Colours Committee consists of at least the following members:
 - The principal,
 - An SMT member,
 - Relevant coaches and
 - A member of the SGB, if required (provided his/her child is not being considered for an award in the relevant activity).
2. Colours are usually awarded at the final assembly in the term in which the activity ends.
3. Each submission for an award must be accompanied by a Motivation form. This form should be completed by the relevant coach.
4. Attainment at previous schools will be taken into consideration when awarding colours to new learners.
5. Only one award per activity may be awarded in any given year.
6. A learner may be re-awarded the same colours award in a subsequent year if the same level of achievement is obtained.
7. One Full Colours Award may be equated with two Half Colours Awards when consideration is being given to nominations for Proficiency Colours.
8. The Principal reserves the right to issue or withhold an award with justifiable cause. In such cases, the Chairman of the Governing Body should be included in the process and a written motivation must be filed in the learner profile.
9. The following colours awards exist:
 - Half Colours (Square Scroll)
 - Full Colours (Blazer Braiding)
10. The following accreditation awards exist:
 - Affiliation (Certificate)
 - Commitment (Certificate)
 - Distinction (Certificate)
11. The following special awards exist (Refer Special Awards Policy):
 - Proficiency Colours (Ornate Scroll)
 - Protean Colours (Honours Blazer)

B. Colours Awards

1. Full Colours (A Team only)

1.1 Generic compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

1.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements

- a. Member of the TNS Netball A Team for two complete seasons.

1.3 Optional qualification requirements (A Team)

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- a. Team places first in league.
- b. Player selected to represent or represents TNS at Provincial level - Gauteng or Eastern District Team.
- c. Team wins at least 80% or more of matches in league and tournament matches played whilst representing TNS.
- d. Holds the position of captain or vice-captain of the D6 team.

2. Half Colours

2.1 Generic compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

2.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements

- a. Member of the TNS Netball Team (A or B) for two complete seasons.

2.3 Optional qualification requirements

2.3.1 A Team

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- a. Team places second in league.
- b. Player selected to play in the D6 team that goes through to Gauteng trials.
- c. Team wins at least 70% - 79% of matches in league and tournament matches played whilst representing TNS.

2.3.2 B Team

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- d. Team places first in league.
- e. Player selected to play in the D6 team that goes through to Gauteng trials.
- f. Team wins at least 80% or more of matches in league (or tournament matches played whilst representing TNS).

C. Accreditation Awards

1. Distinction Award

Compulsory requirements (A Team)

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Netball A Team for one complete season.
- e. Team wins 65% - 69% of matches in league and tournament matches played whilst representing TNS.

Compulsory requirements (B Team)

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Netball B Team for one complete season.
- e. Team wins at least 75% - 79% of matches in league and tournament matches played whilst representing TNS.

2. Commitment Award

Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Netball Team (A or B) for two complete seasons.

3. Affiliation Award

Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.

- a. Absence from practices or matches without valid excuse.
- b. Absence from more than 25% or more of practices or matches, particularly in a team sport/activity.

2. Supporting documents should be available if requested.
3. The Sport Co-Ordinator should gather all the relevant submissions and present them at the Awards Meeting.

5. **A copy of the signed motivation form MUST be stored in a master file that is controlled and kept safe by the School Sport Co-ordinator (this responsibility extends to and includes all extra-mural awards).**
