## A. General Information

1. The Colours Committee consists of at least the following members:
  - The principal,
  - An SMT member,
  - Relevant coaches and
  - A member of the SGB, if required (provided his/her child is not being considered for an award in the relevant activity).
2. Colours are usually awarded at the final assembly in the term in which the activity ends.
3. Each submission for an award must be accompanied by a Motivation form. This form should be completed by the relevant coach.
4. Attainment at previous schools will be taken into consideration when awarding colours to new learners.
5. Only one award per activity may be awarded in any given year.
6. A learner may be re-awarded the same colours award in a subsequent year if the same level of achievement is obtained.
7. One Full Colours Award may be equated with two Half Colours Awards when consideration is being given to nominations for Proficiency Colours.
8. The principal reserves the right to issue or withhold an award with justifiable cause. In such cases, the Chairman of the Governing Body should be included in the process and a written motivation must be filed in the learner profile.
9. The following colours awards exist:
  - Half Colours (Square Scroll)
  - Full Colours (Blazer Braiding)
10. The following accreditation awards exist:
  - Affiliation (Certificate)
  - Commitment (Certificate)
  - Distinction (Certificate)
11. The following special awards exist (Refer Special Awards Policy):
  - Proficiency Colours (Ornate Scroll)
  - Protean Colours (Honours Blazer)

## B. Colours Awards

### 1. Full Colours

#### **1.1 Generic compulsory requirements**

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

#### **1.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements**

- a. Member of the TNS Tumbling Team for two complete seasons during which at least 80% of competitions are attended at Level 4 or higher.

### 1.3 Activity specific compulsory requirements

Learners must meet at least one of the following requirements.

- a. Must accumulate a score to the equivalent of 80% or more calculated on the point allocation table for tumbling, as a member of the TNS Tumbling Team. Must score to 8.2 or higher in at least 3 competitions.
- b. Must score to 8.2 or higher in at least 3 competitions.
- c. Must qualify for and be invited to represent TNS as part of a recognized National Team in a recognized International/National Competition.
- d. Must place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at a recognized National Competition.

## 2. Half Colours

### 2.1 Generic compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

### 2.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements

Member of the TNS Tumbling Team for two complete seasons during which at least 80% of competitions are attended at Level 1, 2 or 3.

### 2.3 Optional qualification requirements

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- a. Must accumulate a score to the equivalent of between 70% and 79% calculated on the point allocation table for tumbling, as a member of the TNS Tumbling Team.
- b. Must score to 8.2 or higher in at least 2 competitions.
- c. Must qualify for and be invited to represent TNS in a recognized East Gauteng / Gauteng / Provincial Competition.

## C. Accreditation Awards

### 1. Distinction Award

#### 1.1 Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of TNS Tumbling Team for 2 complete seasons at which at least 70% of competitions are attended.
- e. Place 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Novice Nationals whilst representing the TNS Team.

## 1.2 Optional qualification requirements

- a. Must place 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Inter-School Meeting whilst representing TNS, in the year of application, in at least two events.
- b. Must place 1<sup>st</sup> at the Inter-School Meeting whilst representing TNS, in the year of application, in at least one event.

## 2. Commitment Award

### Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of TNS Tumbling Team for 2 complete seasons at which at least 70% of competitions are attended.
- e. Place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any 2 competitions whilst representing the TNS Team OR place 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Novice Nationals whilst representing the TNS Team.

## 3. Affiliation Award

### Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of TNS Tumbling Team for 1 complete season at which at least 70% of competitions are attended.

- b. Absence from more than 25% or more of practices or matches, particularly in a team sport/activity.

5. **A copy of the signed motivation form MUST be stored in a master file that is controlled and kept safe by the School Sport Co-ordinator (this responsibility extends to and includes all extra-mural awards).**
