

A. General Information

- 1. The Colours Committee consists of at least the following members:
 - The principal,
 - An SMT member,
 - Relevant coaches and
 - A member of the SGB, if required (provided his/her child is not being considered for an award in the relevant activity).
- 2. Colours are usually awarded at the final assembly in the term in which the activity ends.
- 3. Each submission for an award must be accompanied by a Motivation form. This form should be completed by the relevant coach. Only individual achievements may be used to motivate an award. Relay/Group events should not be taken into account.
- 4. Attainment at previous schools will be taken into consideration when awarding colours to new learners.
- 5. Only one award per activity may be awarded in any given year.
- 6. A learner may be re-awarded the same colours award in a subsequent year if the same level of achievement is obtained.
- 7. One Full Colours Award may be equated with two Half Colours Awards when consideration is being given to nominations for Proficiency Colours.
- 8. The Principal reserves the right to issue or withhold an award with justifiable cause. In such cases, the Chairman of the Governing Body should be included in the process and a written motivation must be filed in the learner profile.
- 9. The following colours awards exist:
 - Half Colours (Square Scroll)
 - Full Colours (Blazer Braiding)
- 10. The following accreditation awards exist:
 - Affiliation (Certificate)
 - Commitment (Certificate)
 - Distinction (Certificate)
- 11. The following special awards exist (Refer Special Awards Policy):
 - Proficiency Colours (Ornate Scroll)
 - Protean Colours (Honours Blazer)

B. Colours Awards

1. Full Colours

1.1 Generic compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

1.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements

- a. Member of the TNS Swimming Team for 2 complete seasons at inter-school level.
- b. Participation in no less than 2 events at Inter Primary. (In the event that a learner

participates in more than 4 events, the 4 highest placings will be used for scoring.)

1.3 Optional qualification requirements

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- a. Must accumulate a score to the equivalent of 80% or higher calculated on the point allocation table for swimming, as a member of the TNS Team. Refer appendix E.
- b. Must represent Tom Newby School at Provincial or National Level, as a member of the East Gauteng/Gauteng Team.
- c. Must represent Tom Newby School at the A-League Gala (if TNS is not participating in the official league as an A-League school) and place first in at least one event.

2. Half Colours

2.1 Generic compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and all official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. Refer appendix D.

2.2 Activity specific compulsory requirements

- a. Member of the TNS Swimming Team for 2 complete seasons at inter-school level.
- b. Participation in no less than 2 events at Inter Primary. (In the event that a learner participates in more than 4 events, the 4 highest placings will be used for scoring.)

2.3 Optional qualification requirements

Candidates must meet at least one of the requirements listed below.

- a. Must accumulate a score to the equivalent of 70%- 79% calculated on the point allocation table for swimming, as a member of the TNS Team. Refer appendix E.
- b. Must represent Tom Newby School at the A-League Gala (if TNS is not participating in the official league as an A-League school) and place in the top three in at least one event.

C. Accreditation Awards

1. Distinction Award

Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours.
 Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Swimming Team for two seasons.
- e. Place 1^{st,} 2nd or 3rd in at least one event at the Inter-Primary Gala whilst representing the TNS Team.

2. Commitment Award

Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Swimming Team for two seasons.

3. Affiliation Award

Compulsory requirements

- a. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Outstanding behaviour and attitude both during school hours and extra mural hours. Refer appendix C.
- b. Dedication, loyalty and full commitment to Tom Newby School and to the extra mural activity as offered by Tom Newby School.
- c. Satisfactory attendance at practices and official tournaments/matches subject to attendance requirements for the extra mural activity. See appendix D.
- d. Member of the TNS Swimming Team for one season.

40 or more entries in the term during which the award is being considered.

The following criteria may result in application for an award being denied:

- a. Absence from practices or meetings without valid excuse.
- b. Absence from more than 25% or more of practices or meetings, particularly in a team sport/activity.

Appendix E: Motivation Form - Swimming

- 1. This form should be completed, on behalf of participants, by the relevant coach and submitted to the Sport Co-Ordinator.
- 2. Supporting documents should be available if requested.
- 3. The Sport Co-Ordinator should gather all the relevant submissions and present them at the Awards Meeting.
- 4. The original signed motivation MUST be placed in the learner profile for future reference.
- 5. A copy of the signed motivation form MUST be stored in a master file that is controlled and kept safe by the School Sport Co-ordinator (this responsibility extends to and includes all extra-mural awards).
