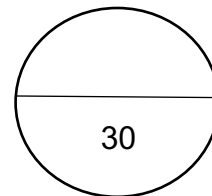

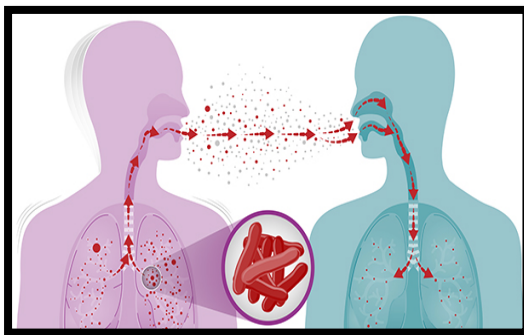

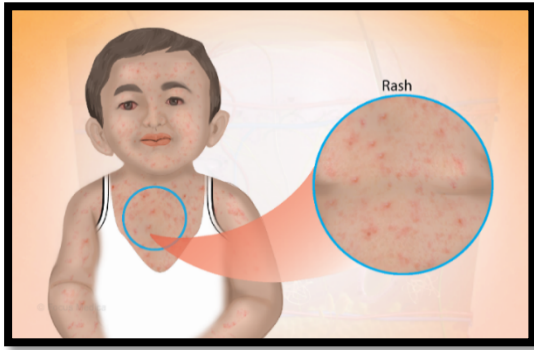

**Prejudice and stigma against HIV and AIDS**

Nkosi Johnson was a South African boy who was born HIV positive. When he was 12 years old, he spoke to a group of 10 000 people because wanted to change attitudes towards HIV and AIDS. Here are some things he said:

“Please help people with AIDS. Support them, care for them. My mommy... was very scared that the community she lived in would find out that we were both infected and chase us away. There was a problem about me going to school. The AIDS workshops were done at the school... to teach them not to fear a child with AIDS. I am very proud to say that there is now a policy for all HIV infected children to be allowed to go to schools and not be discriminated against. I want people to understand AIDS, to be careful and respect AIDS. You can't get AIDS if you touch, hug, kiss, or hold hands with someone who is infected. Care for us and accept us – we are all human beings. We are normal. We have hands. We have feet. We can walk, we can talk, we have needs just like everyone else. Don't be afraid of us. We are all the same!”
